To: Mr. Oscar Dillard, Roseland, Nelson County, Virginia.


Note on front side: I received your card. Many thanks for the same. How are [you] feeling after your trip? K.L.H

To: Miss Kate Dillard Roseland, Virginia Note: January 15 1911. Sunday afternoon










